PROJECT MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME BEGINS AT CIT

CIT's Centre for Advanced Manufacturing and Management Systems (CAMMS) is a offering Project Management programme commencing on Friday October 19th. The full programme consists of 15 full days, to be delivered over six months. The programme is made up of three modules (two at level 8 and one at level 9) each of which can be taken separately. The full programme is accredited as a 15 credit Special Purpose Award at level 8 on the National Framework of Qualifications.

The course content is strongly aligned with the Project Management Institute's (PMI) 'Project Management Body of Knowledge' (PMBOK®). Days 9 and 10 also serve as a two-day 'boot camp' in preparation for the examination for accreditation as a Project Management Professional (PMP) with the PMI.

Those already holding PMP status can take Module 3 as 36 Professional Development Units (PDUs) towards maintaining their accreditation. Those who have already taken project management courses with CAMMS may be exempt from a portion of the first module.

The course will be held over six months, (approximately one Friday and Saturday per month), commencing on Friday October 19th, in the CAMMS Centre's new location in the Zero2020 facility (Room B287).
